### **PRAYER DESK (3 - 9 April 2016)**

**PSW.** Pray for: (a) Michael Wong, recently appointed Project Executive Director-Designate. Pray for God's anointing for this critical role which oversees overall co-ordination of the project. Pray for good communication with all relevant parties, including SJSJ staff team. (b) Study trip (6-13 April) by a team of 7 PSW committee members (led by Michael) to Seattle and Tokyo to learn the various models for integrating pre-school and nursing home. Pray for wisdom and discernment, and good interaction with the operators of the overseas facilities. (c) Renovation / relocation of church office and facilities. Pray for the church staff to be united in spirit and vision, and for the smooth and timely transition before construction work begins.

**AGM (17 Apr).** Pray for this important gathering of the body of Christ. May SJSJMers gather in good spirits and a humble posture. May decisions be made in accordance with God's will.
