PSW. Pray for: (a) The building design. May it be guided by the Lord even in the details. Pray that our Dover neighbours receive it well. (b) The study trip to Tokyo & Seattle (6-13 April) by 7 committee members to learn the various models for integrating pre-school and nursing home.
