FOR YOUR 'FAMILY PRAYER TIME'

Readings: Psalm 146; 1 Kings 17:17-24; Luke 7:11-23

Collect: Almighty God, whose Son Jesus Christ is the resurrection and the life of all who put their trust in Him: raise us, we pray, from the death of sin to the life of righteousness; that we may seek the things which are above, where He reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen.

PRAYER DESK (17 - 23 April 2016)

"Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words." Ro 8:26

PSW. Pray for: (a) The building design. Pray for SJSMers to exhibit spiritual maturity in the manner of giving and processing feedback on the design. May the design be guided by the Lord even in the details. Pray for our Dover neighbours to receive it well. (b) The renovation / relocation of church office and facilities. Pray for the church staff to be united in spirit and vision, and for the transition to take place smoothly. (c) Divine favour with the relevant government authorities as the committee liaises with them over various issues. (d) Principal-Designate for Pre-School Centre. May God send His appointee.
