Readings: Psalm 29; Isaiah 6:1-8; Revelation 4

Collect: Almighty and everlasting God, You have given us Your servants grace, by the confession of a true faith to acknowledge the glory of the eternal Trinity, and in the power of the divine Majesty to worship the Unity. Keep us steadfast in this faith, that we may evermore be defended from all adversities; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who is alive and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen.

PRAYER DESK (22 – 28 May 2016)

*"Seek the LORD and His strength;
seek His presence continually!" 1 Chronicles 16:11*

PSW. Pray for the PSW committees to seek the Lord and His presence continually. May they be guided by the Lord in the design of the building and facilities, as well as the programmes for the Spring and Winter components. Pray anointing over Michael Wong, the Project Executive Director as he provides leadership to the overall co-ordination of PSW.
