FOR YOUR 'FAMILY PRAYER TIME'

Readings: Ps. 92, 146; 2 Sam. 15: 17-21; Jn. 11:1-16

Collect: Lord, you have taught us that all our doings without love are nothing worth. Send your Holy Spirit and pour into our hearts that most excellent gift of love, the true bond of peace and of all virtues, without which whoever lives is counted dead before you. Grant this for the sake of your only Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

PRAYER DESK (3 - 9 July 2016)

"...please show me now Your ways, that I may know You in order to find favor in Your sight." Ex 33:13

PSW.
