The scarlet blooms of the crown anemone, a common wildflower in Israel, spotlight the liturgical colour for this feast: red, symbolising fire and blood.

CHRIST THE KING.

This feast, which falls on Sun, 20 Nov this vear and whose liturgical colour is red (symbolising blood and fire), is a proclamation of the complete authority of Christ as King over all creation. While it was only instituted in 1925 and adopted by the Anglican Church in 1970, its placement on the final Sunday before Advent is a fitting culmination of the church year: beginning in Advent with the hope of the promised Messiah. we end with a celebration of the triumphant, risen Saviour.

LECTIONARY READINGS: Psalms 29, 110; Zechariah 6:9–end; Revelation 11:15–18 **COLLECT:** God the Father, help us to hear the call of Christ the King and to follow in His service, whose kingdom has no end; for He reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, one glory. Amen.

OUR PARISH

- <u>CCPG (25 Nov)</u>. Pray for fruitful research to address the wide-ranging causes of mental stress, and to help develop mental health promotion measures. (b) Pray for an outpouring of the Spirit upon our young people and a thriving youth discipleship movement to bring spiritual, mental, and emotional healing and transformation. (Joel 2:28; Ps 34:17–19)

THE WORLD

Cllimate. Pray that, following the recent UN Climate Change Conference, the nations (especially the superpowers) will follow through with constructive actions to work towards the critical targets for reducing greenhouse gas emission, and to forge effective partnerships to find solutions to the existential global crisis. Pray for the next generation to rise up as a powerful voice and agent of change on global warming.
