LECTIONARY READINGS: Psalm 71:1–6 15–17; Haggai 2:1–9; 1 Corinthians 3:10–17

COLLECT: Almighty God, in Christ You make all things new. Transform the poverty of our nature by the riches of Your grace, and in the renewal of our lives make known Your heavenly glory; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

OUR PARISH

- **Chinese New Year (CNY) Season.** Give thanks to God for His redemptive work in every season, and His desire to strengthen family relationships. May He help deepen our bonding with relatives and friends during this CNY season, and make us His channels of blessings.
