

Skills Impartation. Participants will be introduced to different expressions of prayer (meditative, petitionary, intercessory, warfare, healing etc) with practicums in small groups.

SET FREE TO PRAY! Michelle Choo

I signed up for the Prayer Training Retreat in 2019, thinking I could retreat to somewhere in JB to spend time with God and just talk to Him. Little did I know that it was a training retreat! What a surprise! Hitherto, I never knew that Christians had to learn to pray. But having gone through it, I realize there is so much to learn!

In the past, whenever I had to pray with others, I would pray things that pleased men instead of trying to hear what the Holy Spirit was prompting me to pray to God. I was also fearful of praying aloud as I was always conscious of what others would think of me and my prayers – no depth, no substance, no power, no eloquence, ... and many more. Driven by low self-esteem, and being easily hurt

and embarrassed, I was probably praying out of my insecurities. But by the grace of God, all that changed as my "retreat" journey continued. After the Retreat, I went on to attend the one-year (twice-monthly) prayer training. I was drawn back to repeat the training two more times as my relationship and intimacy with God deepened slowly, but surely.

In my third year attending the training, I experienced a spiritual awakening. The anointed teaching based on Scriptures set me free, healing me of my painful past. It was such a blessing for me! I was also blessed with an extraordinary loving and caring practicum group leader. Together with the group of very encouraging ladies, we learned, prayed and grew together in our intimacy with God. Not only did we learn how to express our prayers in various forms to God in our practicum sessions, our friendship grew as we learned to intercede for others and fellowshipped even outside the training sessions.

God has given me courage to pray for my loved ones, friends and even acquaintances in private or in public. I am set free to pray! I no longer fear praying, or fear being "judged" by others in the way I pray as I learn to be led by the Holy Spirit. May the Heavenly Father empower me to live my life worthy of His calling!

GOD IS NO LONGER A VENDING MACHINE **Carol Au**

In my many years as a Christian, I used to think that my identity was tied to what I did for a living. Consequently, I put all my effort in working very hard in my banking job for decades. However, all my worldly aspirations crumbled down one day a few years ago when my health took a hit. After my resignation, I felt insecure, lost and guestioned who I was. That was when I started my desperate journey to seek God more intentionally. Prior to this, my walk with God was superficial, mainly just to fulfill my Christian responsibility by serving in church and seeking people's approval rather than God's will. My prayer life too was just a one-way communication with God, as if I was inserting requests into a vending machine and expecting Him to answer them.

Then one day last year, my sister told me about the 3-day Prayer Training Retreat (PTR 2022). I decided to accompany her. Little did I know that God would change my prayer life forever. On the second day of the retreat however, my sister experienced headaches, and I, headaches and nightmares that would not go away. We almost gave up but I felt God nudging me to persevere, no matter what it took. I obeyed. Once I acted in faith, the headaches just disappeared. Others like the PTR Team were also praying for us.

Having learnt so much at the PTR, I wanted more. This spurred me to join the 8-month Prayer Training (PT), conducted twice monthly. Through our small group practicum, my group leaders prayed for me, and God healed me of vertigo. Through their prayers, He has also delivered me from persistent nightmares, fear and oppression. All glory to Him! I am very grateful for my leaders' loving encouragement and great dedication to God's cause in PT.

God was also so gracious in allowing me to witness His marvelous works for other participants at PT. At the end of the course, I believe I am no longer the same compared to what I was before. My faith in Jesus has grown and I am no longer living in fear. Prayer is no longer a daunting task, or like inserting requests into a vending machine. Now I see prayers as means to build a deeper relationship with God. Jesus has given me victory over my sickness and fear. Through Him, I am set free and He made me His own. I am a child of the Most High God. Jesus, my Lord and Savior, is my exceedingly Great Reward.
