#### PENTECOST / WHITSUNDAY.

While the liturgical colour for most of Eastertide is white, it changes to red — the colour of blood and fire — for Pentecost. during which the church celebrates the Holy Spirit's comina (and appearing as tongues of flame) on the disciples who were gathered in the Upper Room. This day is also known as Whitsunday; this name arose from the traditional Anglican practice of having that day's baptism candidates (and also the rest of the congregation) dressed in white to convey their purity in their new birth.


