THE WORLD

• Israel-Gaza War. Pray for (a) divine restraint over all alliances on each side of the conflict so as to avoid an all out war in the Middle-East; (b) acceleration of adequate humanitarian aids to reach the refugees, healing of those afflicted, and the release of all hostages; (c) Arab and Jewish believers in all nations to be united in their love for the Lord and for one another, that they may inspire others to release forgiveness and to seek the Way that leads to true peace (Jn 13:34–35); (d) peaceful resolution, for God's mercy to be shown and His rule to be manifest over the nations.


