ADVENT.

We begin the church vear with the end in mind, reflecting on the need for Jesus' first coming and looking forward to His return as a conquering King and righteous Judge. Each Sunday of Advent, one additional Advent candle is lit. culminating in the lighting of the Christ candle on Christmas **Eve/Christmas Day to** celebrate Jesus' birth and His coming as the light of the world. The five candles (three purple, one pink/rose, one white) typically symbolise prophecy/ hope, the Way (out of darkness), joy, peace, and Christ Himself (prophecy fulfilled). Some churches also associate the candles with the Patriarchs, the Prophets, John the Baptist, the virgin Mary, and Christ, such that the four Sundays of Advent remind us of those who prepared the Lord's people for His coming.
