PALM SUNDAY.

Palm Sunday recalls Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem to celebrate Passover with His disciples, and His being thronged by welcoming crowds waving palm branches and shouting 'Hosanna'. This event, which marks the beginning of the Passion narrative, is mentioned in all four of the Synoptic Gospels. The brightly coloured ripe fruit of the common Middle Eastern shrub Sarcopoterium spinosum reflects the liturgical colour for this day - red - which symbolises blood (particularly the shedding of blood) and fire.

LECTIONARY READINGS: Psalms 61, 62; Zechariah 9:9–12; 1 Corinthians 2:1–12
