#### **EASTERTIDE.**

The Great 50 Days of Faster are a celebration of Christ's Resurrection and everything that it means. It runs from Resurrection Sunday through Ascension Day (Thu, 9 May) to Pentecost (Sun, 19 May); the nine-day gap between the latter dates is meant to be kept as a time of prayer and preparation to celebrate the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. This season, we feature the white blooms of Commiphora myrrha, which many scholars believe is the source of the myrrh that is mentioned so many times in scripture (Commiphora habessinica is another contender).




