What is the focus of this retreat?

Discussions around identity and relationships have always been important. Today, with the rapid infiltration of social media, we have been exposed to many new ideas about sexuality, relationships and self-identity. Without a foundational understanding of these core topics, we may find ourselves directionless and confused on the importance of community and relationships in our lives.

The 2024 Young Adults Retreat seeks to provide a space to learn biblical perspectives and have open discussions on core topics such as identity, singleness, marriage, friendships, and more.

The sessions are designed to be practical and applicational to address core issues that young adults in Singapore face. While these sessions reinforce our foundational understanding of these topics, the intentionally-light schedule gives space for safe discussions and sharing to foster relationships among church community.

Rt. Rev. David Burke brings with him a rich background in pastoral care and Christian education. He currently serves as Moderator-General of the Presbyterian Church of Australia and, has been a Theological-Lecturer in Christ College Sydney for over 13 years. Previously, he was based in Singapore as Senior Minister for Orchard Road Presbyterian Church for 12 years.

Character Formation. In order to listen well to the Lord and pray His will with His anointing, we need to be clean vessels.



Spiritual Restoration. Participants will be given the opportunity to be prayed for (infilling of the Spirit, healing, etc).



Skills Impartation. Participants will be introduced to different expressions of prayer (meditative, petitionary, intercessory, warfare, healing etc) with practicums in small groups.

ALL ABOUT MY RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD by Jeannie Koh

I attended the Prayer Training Retreat (PTR) and the 9-month Prayer Training (PT) in 2022 as well as 2023—the topics covered do vary and are highly applicable to our daily walk with God.

In 2022, I felt led by God to attend to learn more about spiritual warfare. Different forms of prayers were taught; we were exposed to the multi-dimensional character of our dialogue with God. We also learnt about the wound of rejection, and I realised that I was dealing with it on multiple fronts, resulting in lots of bitterness. I realised I had to take action, renew my mind, and replace destructive feelings with godly ones so that I could be free.

The second time round, I invited a friend to attend PTR with me and experienced first-hand how the enemy tries all ways and means to prevent us

from coming near to God. I'm a nurse, and I learnt that prayer works in ways that defy medical knowledge when we stand firm in our faith and take authority in Jesus' name. I learnt the beauty of full surrender and resting in God, despite impossible circumstances.

The PT teaching is application-focused. Lots of personal testimonies and case studies mean that the lessons are interesting, and easy to understand and apply, even for new believers like me. The lesson on stillness, solitude, and silence has helped me focus on God alone, and reinforced the importance of discipline in my prayer life. The sharing on listening to God through the Scriptures helped me to dive deeper and understand God's word from a perspective that I never thought possible.

I look at prayer in a different light now; it is indeed not about **how** we pray but all about our own **relationship** with God. I truly thank God for giving me this avenue to know Him better and hear His voice. I also love being in a highly supportive group environment that ensures no one is left out!

I CAN LAMENT! by Hephzibah Ho

I grew up in a dysfunctional family in which violence was common—at times I didn't know if I would wake up if I allowed myself to sleep. Self-expression and voicing of opinions were aggressively discouraged; survival instinct in the midst of frustrated helplessness and anger meant that emotional suppression has been a coping mechanism for most of my life.

It was an oppressive environment where fear was my constant companion. When faced with difficult, unjust or unkind treatment, I often wanted to speak up but was constantly overruled, and threatened by adults not to open my mouth. I ended up wallowing in negativity while bottling everything up inside. It was very

unhealthy. I felt belittled and unworthy. The result of that was seen in the many physical and emotional problems that assailed me over the years.

All that started to change when I attended PTR and the 9-month prayer training in 2022 and 2023.

I was so thankful when we were taught that we can lament to God. Can meh? My whole face lit up; I knew my eyes were sparkling as I strained to listen as carefully as possible to confirm that I had heard correctly. The book of Psalms is our evidence: David—a man who was so close to God and who wrote many of the Psalms, could freely lament to Him. I have licence to speak up. Oh, yes! The word 'lament' is now part of my vocabulary. I can freely express myself and release my emotional burdens to our Abba Father without fear! I thank Him too that by His grace, through prayer ministry, I am learning to walk in freedom from rejection, fear, and emotional woundedness. All glory to Him!

I look forward to every session, for new insights and deeper understanding on repeat topics and for new ones that are introduced as the Spirit leads. I've also benefited from the honest sharing—yes, with both tears and laughter—within our small group.
