

OUR PARISH

- SJSM Village (SJSMV) Engagement Weekend (29-30 June). Give thanks to God for taking us from SJSM to SJSMV that we may grow in experiential knowledge of Him as we learn to seek and obey His leading. Pray for more SJSMers to explore ways of getting involved in SJSMV as part of our faith journey, trusting God to show us what He can do through a people yielded to Him (Eph 3:20). May we submit to His pruning that He may bring forth abundant fruitfulness (maturity, ministry, mission) that brings Him glory.

Pray also for the SJSM cross-cultural workers (4 based in Timor Leste, 2 in Cambodia) and their local co-workers – may they be greatly encouraged by the mission teams and be refreshed and strengthened in the Lord.

• Shalom Singapore. May the recent spate of serious accidents (ship collision with Baltimore bridge in March, SQ321's encounter with severe turbulence in May, maritime collision causing extensive oil spills in June) serve as a wake-up call that reminds of our nation's dependency on God's sovereign mercy (Ro 9:14-16; Ps 127:1). May we choose to give thanks to God for His gracious reminder, and repent of any sin of pride and presumptuousness. Pray for His divine protection over Singapore, and for wisdom to guide our government in managing these difficult incidents.

• **Middle East.** [BBC: Israel and Hezbollah move closer to all-out war.] Pray for God's merciful intervention in the escalating conflict between Israel and Hezbollah, that an all-out war may be avoided. May God cause desperate hearts in the land to become totally receptive to the revelation of Jesus, the Prince of Peace. (Is 9:6)


