- **Prayer Life.** (a) Pray for a holy hunger for the Lord and a desperation for personal revival, that we may turn to God to fill us with His Spirit that moves us to pray heart-changing prayers. OUR NATION

• Sexual Aberrations. [Annual Crime Brief reported increasing trend in voyeurism offences; Singapore Police Force Sexual Crime Awareness Seminar 2024 reported a jump of about 30% in the arrest of youths for sexual crimes in 2023]. Pray for (a) strong discipleship in the churches and Christian homes to guard our flock, especially our youngsters, from falling into the traps of sexual seduction, such as pornography; (b) wisdom for the government in introducing a wide range of measures to promote public awareness and communal efforts to combat this social malady; (c) perpetrators who prey on others to be exposed, brought to justice, and be rehabilitated; (d) improved training for counsellors who work with children and youth to spot early signs of harmful sexual behaviour, and for enhanced support for victims of sexual offences; (e) spiritual revival to bring conviction and repentance in the land (2 Ch 7:14).

THE WORLD


• Climate. [News: Alaskan glaciers melting at 'incredibly worrying' pace; unprecedented, rapidly intensifying hurricane 'Beryl' an 'alarming harbinger of the future', threatening catastrophic floods; etc.] Pray for world leaders, especially of the superpowers, to muster every political will to make it their top priority to save the planet from her existential crisis (Gen 2:15). Pray repentance over the root sins of climate crisis – the maximising of self-interest at the expense of the poor and of the future generations. Pray for revival and purification of the Church, that she may understand the times and know what she should do to reach the world in need of Christ.
