• Loneliness. [CNA: Recent Institute of Policy Studies poll showed that young Singaporeans aged 21 to 34 faced the highest levels of loneliness and social isolation. The World Health Organisation (WHO) has declared loneliness to be a global health threat.] Pray for (a) greater public awareness of loneliness as a prevalent and serious social issues; (b) a profound sense of empathy to initiate better understanding and bonding with those who may be lonely; (c) a change in social perspective towards mental health issues in general, so that sufferers may not be hindered by social stigma from seeking help; (d) protection of the lonely from harmful coping mechanisms that may render them vulnerable to addiction, bad actors, etc; (e) believers to be ready to work with the Holy Spirit to touch those who are lonely, that they may find fulfilment through a personal relationship with Jesus.

• **United States.** Pray for peaceful transition of power and unity of the Church following the recent presidential election. May the Lord guide the new leadership in her role on the world stage, to uphold justice and work towards early resolution of military conflicts in Ukraine and the Middle East. (Pr 29:2)
