NEW COMMUNITY SPACE - CANA LOUNGE

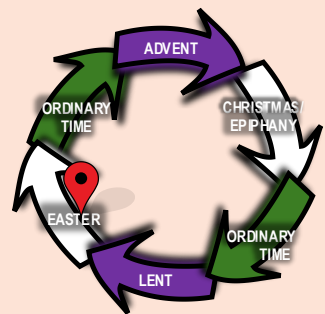

OUR PARISH
