2025 MARRIAGE PREPARATION COURSE (7 Saturdays)

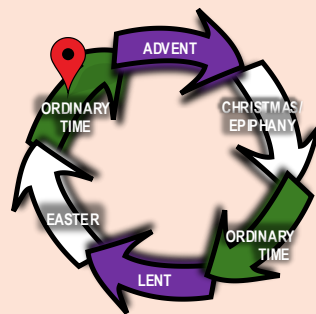

LECTIONARY READINGS: Psalm 55.1-16; 18-21 Deuteronomy 11.1-15; Acts 27.1-12
COLLECT: Almighty and everlasting God, by whose Spirit the whole body of the Church is governed and sanctified: hear our prayer which we offer for all Your faithful people; that each in his vocation and ministry may serve You in holiness and truth to the glory of Your name; through our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen.

OUR PARISH

- **YAGUI (Young Adults Ground Up Initiative) YAP.** Commit our young adults to God, praying they be firmly established in His love and truth. May He redeem human actions for His higher purpose (Gen 50:20), awakening hearts in both Israel and Iran and drawing many to Yeshua, the true and lasting peace.
