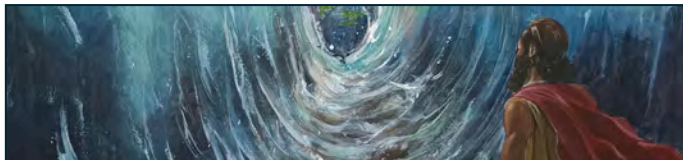

## SJSM VILLAGE (SJSMV)

### OUR PARISH
