## 10<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY AFTER TRINITY

*LECTIONARY READINGS:* Psalms 86, 117; Genesis 28.10-17; John 1.43-end

*COLLECT:* Almighty Father, whose Son Jesus Christ has taught us that what we do for the least of our brethren we do also for Him; give us the will to be the servant of others as He was the servant of all, who gave up His life and died for us, but is alive and reigns with You and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen.

### SJSM VILLAGE (SJSMV)

#### OUR PARISH

- **Leaders Gathering 30 Aug (LG):** Pray strong anointing of the Holy Spirit upon Ps Tak Meng, empowering him to helm his first LG with wisdom and clarity in casting the vision, setting the tone and paving the way ahead for SJSMV.
