

Pray that His purposes prevail in deliberations and decisions on Gaza and Ukraine conflicts, AI governance, climate action, humanitarian aid and multilateral cooperation. May He direct the global leaders like streams of water (Pr 21:1) during the High-Level General Debate (23-27 & 29 Sep). Though non-binding, UNGA resolutions shape global norms and diplomatic agendas. May outcomes reflect God's sovereignty, justice, mercy, care for the vulnerable and stewardship of creation.
