






Easter Triptych based on Luke 24

MEET CHRIST IN THE SACRAMENT



When he was at table with them, he took the bread and blessed and broke it and gave it to them.

And their eyes were opened, and they recognized him. Luke 24 : 30-31

The Last Supper provides the scriptural basis for the Eucharist, also known as "Holy Communion" or "The Lord's Supper".

MEET CHRIST IN THE SACRAMENT

The Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist

is the Christian doctrine that Jesus Christ is present in the Eucharist, not merely symbolically or metaphorically, but in a true and substantial way.

THE 39 ARTICLES OF RELIGION | XXVIII OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

The Supper of the Lord is not only a sign of the love that Christians ought to have among themselves one to another; but rather is a Sacrament of our **Redemption by Christ's death:** insomuch that to such as rightly, worthily, and with faith, receive the same, the Bread which we break is a partaking of the Body of Christ; and likewise the Cup of Blessing is a partaking of the Blood of Christ. **Transubstantiation** (or the change of the substance of Bread and Wine) in the Supper of the Lord, cannot be proved by holy Writ; but **is repugnant to the plain words of Scripture**, overthroweth the nature of a Sacrament, and hath given occasion to many superstitions.

"Do this in remembrance of me"

MEET CHRIST IN THE SACRAMENT

For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, "This is my body which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me."
In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood.
Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."
1 Corinthians 11 : 24-25

"In every place where I caused my name to be remembered, I will come to you and bless you." Exodus 20 : 24
