A. Mental Distress

Mental Distress is an Experience of being troubled and unwell inside

- Emotions: Anxiety, sadness, mood swings, overwhelmed, etc.
- Thinking: Intrusive, obsessive, confusing thoughts, etc.
- Physical effects: On sleep, appetite, weight, energy level, physical discomfort, etc.
- Spiritual condition: Far from God, loss of hope/purpose/ meaning/direction, etc.
- Behaviour: Compulsions, irritability, substances (incl. food), etc.₅

Mental Illness



- Mental Illnesses are medically-defined health disorders that affect our mood (emotional regulation), thinking (cognition) and behaviour (functioning) associated with distress and problems in social, work or family life.
- Mental illness is an illness like any other (like diabetes, high blood pressure, etc) that can be treated and managed.

Mental Illness: Examples



- Mood disorders: Depression, bipolar disorder, etc.
- Anxiety disorders: Obsessive-compulsive disorder, generalized anxiety disorder, phobias, etc.
- Post-traumatic stress disorder: Depression, anxiety, etc.
- Addictions: Substance and process addictions
- Psychosis (break from reality): Schizophrenia, paranoia, dissociative disorders, etc.

An experience of Mental Distress is not always a Mental Illness.

- Mental illness needs to be diagnosed by a medical professional according to established clinical procedures and criteria, so that safe and effective treatment and care can be provided.
- Do not self-diagnose or label others.

Mental Distress and Mental Illness

- Severe mental distress could indeed be a mental illness.
- Unattended mental distress could over time worsen into mental illness.
- Delay in seeking professional help: Unnecessary suffering and does not improve outcomes.


B. Satan and Sin






Enters Satan: Who is he? What does he do?


- Satan is personified as the Serpent:
 - "Now the serpent was more crafty than any other beast of the field that the LORD God had made." (Gen 3:1)
- A created being, like all others; not God.
- A crafty being bends the truth:
 - "Father of lies" (John 8:44), "tempter" (Matt 4:1-3), "accuser" (Rev 12:10), "to kill, steal and destroy" (John 10:10).




Gen 3:1-10 Satan's Goal is to separate us from God who made us in His own image.



Gen 3:1-10 Satan's Strategy is to make us doubt, reject and disobey God (Sin).



Disconnected from God by Satan and Sin, we become Disordered and Distressed



...out of order and alignment with God

Satan and Sin has caused Distress to all Humanity by corrupting our relationship with God, with others, with creation and even with

ourselves

Gen 3:17 cursed is the ground because of you; in pain you shall eat of it all the days of your life; 18 thorns and thistles it shall bring forth for you; 19 By the sweat of your face you shall eat bread, till you return to the ground"

With Creation (Overuse, abuse and neglect)

(Broken Communion) (Emotional brokenness, biological disorder)

With God

Gen 3:10 And he said, "I heard the sound of you in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked, and I hid myself."

Gen 3:12 The man said, "The woman whom you gave to be with me, she gave me fruit of the tree, and I ate." 13 ... The woman said, "The serpent deceived me, and I ate."

With Others (Distrust and manipulation)

Humanity falls into Distress as we strive in vain to meet our deepest needs without God:

Jer. 2:13 for my people have... forsaken me, the fountain of living waters, and hewed out cisterns for themselves, broken cisterns that can hold no water.

- Lacking SECURITY, we compete to protect ourselves by working harder, being stronger, so that no one can hurt us. But we still get hurt, and in turn hurt others. → Bullying, abuse, trauma, irrational fears.
- Lacking SIGNIFICANCE, we counterfeit it with honours, job titles, influence over others, etc. → Delusions, anxiety, shame, etc.
- Lacking SELF-WORTH, we strive to achieve and accumulate more than others. When we fail, we feel worthless, and life is meaningless.
 - → Burnout, depression, negative self-talk, etc.





Satan/Sin and Mental Distress/Illness

- Mental Distress/Illness is the reality of living broken lives in a disordered and fallen world.
- With the exception of Satanism and persistent moral depravity, there is no biblical, theological or scientific basis to say that every instance of Mental Distress/Illness is directly caused by Satan's activity or personal sin.



C. Our Hope: Redemption in Christ

God had a plan from the beginning

- The seed of the woman shall bruise the serpent's head (Gen 3:15 - the First Gospel)
- The first sacrifice of blood (Gen 3:21 skin garments)
- The covenant people (Gen 12:2-3 rhe Abrahamic Covenant)
- The emptying of Christ: to become human to redeem us from our sin (John 1:14, Phil 2:5-8)
- We are chosen to be saved, along with all creation (Rom 8:21), before the foundation of the world (Eph 1:4; 1 Pet 1:18-19)



In Christ, we are reconciled with God and restored to God's fold for healing and wholeness

• John 10:10 The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly. 11 I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep... 14 I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me.



Recovery of Mental Wellness: Personal transformation and growth

- Spirituality: Draw closer, be centred on God.
- Choices: Choose to lean upon God for all our Security, Significance and Self-worth.
- Mind: Develop new mindset, attitudes and self-talk based on God's promises and the example of Christ. Counselling based on Christian principles.
- **Emotions:** Release our emotions to God and trusted matured brethren. Pain shared is pain halved.
- Physical: Medication, nutrition, work, exercise, rest.
- Relationships: Journey prayerfully with one another toward wholeness (no more fear or stigma).
