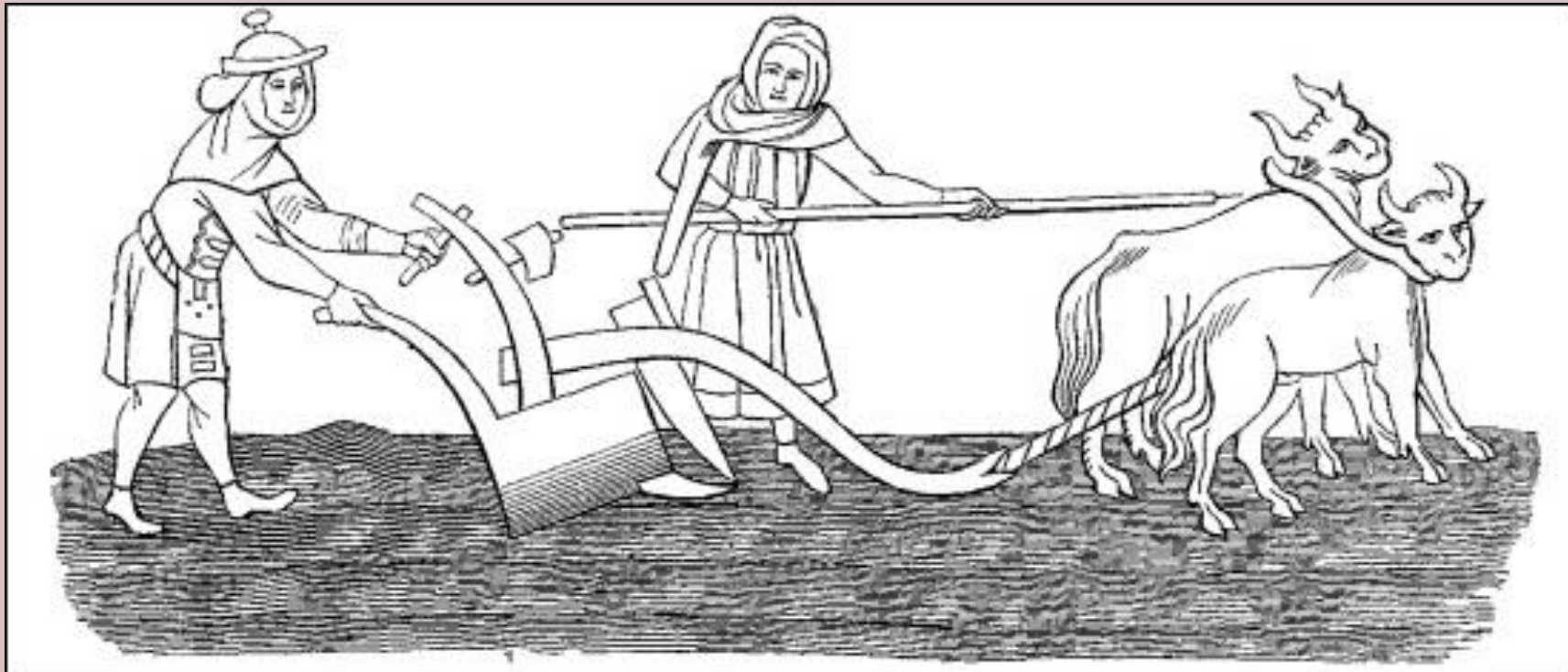
Acts 26:14

- ★ **Free Man – Roman Citizen, believed Jesus was an imposter and a liar**





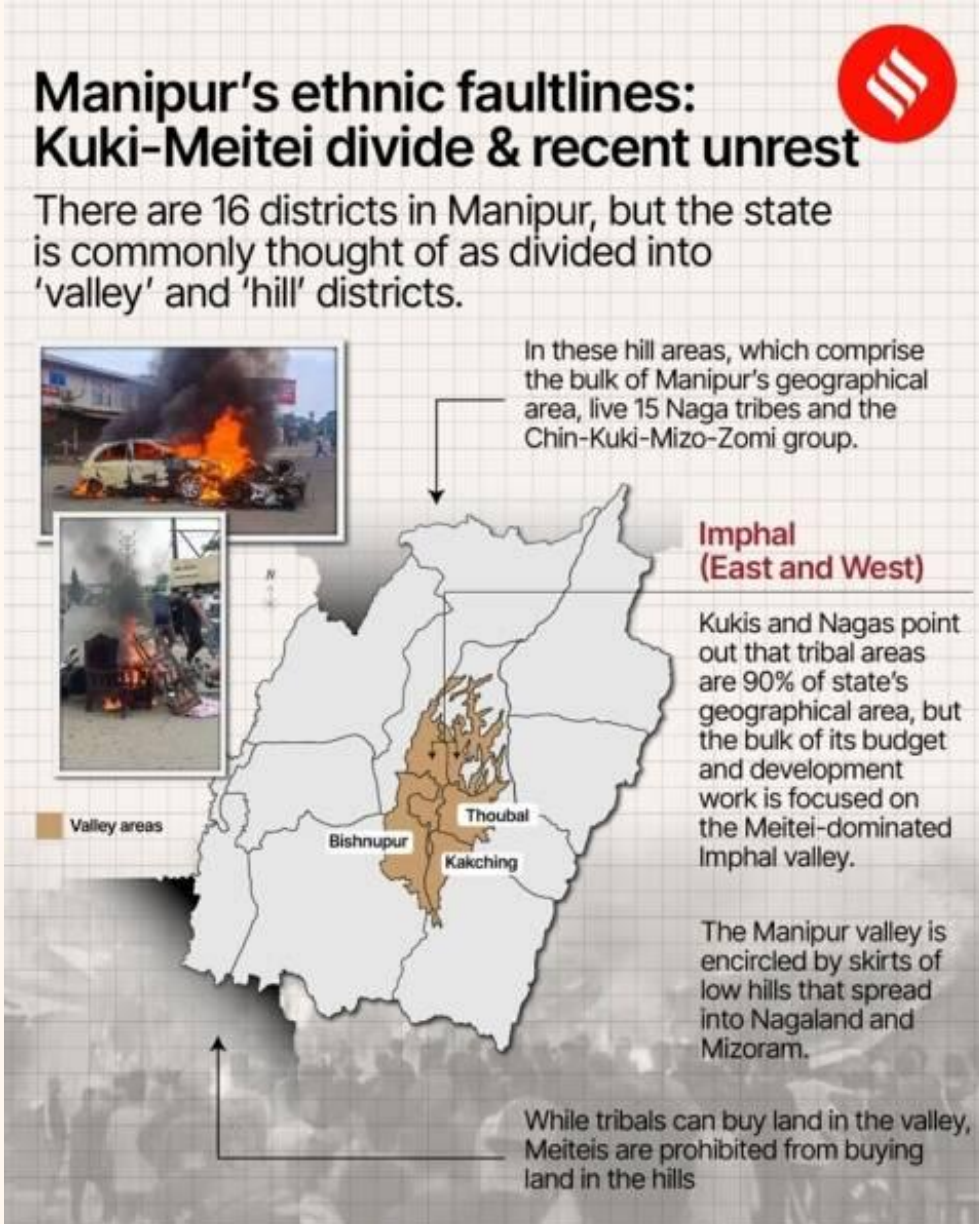


Acts 26:17b-18
