



Gethsemane

- Place for the pressing of oil
- Olive field
- Olive press: for extracting oil from olive fruits





Olive Crusher & Oil Press


REMOVETHIS CUP Jesus in Agony

- Distressed & troubled (Mk 14:33)
- Overwhelmed with sorrow to point of death (Mt 26:38)
- Sweat became like drops of blood (Lk 22:44): <u>hematidrosis</u>



REMOVETHIS CUP The Cup

- Cup of suffering
 - Torture & humiliation
 - Brutality of crucifixion




REMOVETHIS CUP The Cup

- Cup of separation
 - Jesus became sin for us
 - Father turned His face away

"My God, My God, why have You forsaken me?" Matthew 27:46




NOT MY WILL BUTYOURS Luke 22:39-46

And He came out and went, as was His custom, to the Mount of Olives, and the disciples followed Him. And when He came to the place, He said to them, "Pray that you may not enter into temptation." And He withdrew from them about a stone's throw, and knelt down and prayed, saying, "Father, if You are willing, remove this cup from Me. Nevertheless, not My will, but Yours, be done." And there appeared to Him an angel from heaven, strengthening Him. And being in agony He prayed more earnestly; and His sweat became like great drops of blood falling down to the ground. And when He rose from prayer, He came to the disciples and found them sleeping for sorrow, and He said to them, "Why are you sleeping? Rise and pray that you may not enter into temptation."

NOT MY WILL BUT YOURS Don't Fall into Temptation

NOT MY WILL BUT YOURS Jesus & the Tempter

- Pray that you may not enter into (fall, give in) TEMPTATION (Luke 22:40, 46)
- Was the tempter present in Gethsemane?





NOT MY WILL BUT YOURS Jesus & the Tempter

- He was present in the wilderness (note Luke 4:13)
- Short cut & easy way: pass the cup & go for the crown without the cross





NOT MY WILL BUT YOURS Jesus & the Tempter

- He worked through Peter (Matt 16): Avoid the cross!
- Jesus' reply: Get behind Me, Satan!





NOT MY WILL BUT YOURS At Gethsemane


- Temptation: take the easy way, pass the cup, go for the crown without the cross
- Jesus: Not My will but Yours be done!





NOT MY WILL BUT YOURS Prayer of Surrender

- Costly prayer: letting go and entrusting ourselves to the Father's will & purposes
- Dear God, Your will: nothing more, nothing less, nothing else!



NOT MY WILL BUT YOURS Prayer of Surrender

 Accepting the call to be bishop: accepting the cup of hardship & sacrifice



When I became the bishop, the Lord reminded me that being a diocesan bishop is not a prize to be won but a cup to be drunk. It is the cup of costly sacrifice, hardship and suffering that Jesus drank when He went to the cross for us. When I took up the office in Oct 2012, this was the question that was ringing in my heart, "Can I drink the cup?" 8 years on, I just want to thank the Lord for giving me the strength to drink the cup. It is His steadfast love that has carried me through.



NOT MY WILL BUT YOURS

- **Prayer of Surrender**
- God gave Jesus the strength to drink the cup
- His all-sufficient grace kept Jesus going, through all the sufferings, enduring the cross
- The same grace is available to us
