

Who is going to convince them that, after all is said and done, there is a safe place to return to and receive an embrace?


If it is not I, who is it going to be?




2. A New Identity and Mission

"By this all people will know that you are my disciples"


So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer


.... it is thus with awe and circumspection, that we should conduct all of our dealings with one another, all friendships, all loves, all play, all politics.
