


Ex 39:32-43 Inspection and Blessing of the Tabernacle

- Then they brought the tabernacle to Moses
 - the tent and all its utensils, its hooks, its frames, its bars, its pillars, and its bases;
 - the covering of tanned rams' skins and goatskins, and the veil of the screen;
 - the ark of the testimony with its poles and the mercy seat;
 - the table with all its utensils, and the bread of the Presence;
 - the lampstand of pure gold and its lamps with the lamps set and all its utensils, and the oil for the light;
 - the golden altar, the anointing oil and the fragrant incense, and the screen for the entrance of the tent;
 - the bronze altar, and its grating of bronze, its poles, and all its utensils; the basin and its stand;
 - the hangings of the court, its pillars, and its bases, and the screen for the gate of the court, its cords, and its pegs;
 - all the utensils for the service of the tabernacle, for the tent of meeting;
 - the finely worked garments for ministering in the Holy Place, the holy garments for Aaron the priest, and the garments of his sons for their service as priests.

 42 According to all that the LORD had commanded Moses, so the people of Israel had done all the work. 43 And Moses saw all the work, and behold, they had done it; as the LORD had commanded, so had they done it. Then Moses blessed them.



Moses received God's revelation of Himself and how **Israel is to be the People of God.**




The Tabernacle: A multi-sensory experience of Who God is, and our relationship with Him.



What spiritual lessons can we learn from the **construction and** blessing of the **Tabernacle?**

THE PARTY

1. God displays His glory and character supremely through His Son Jesus Christ

- Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son... (Heb 1:1-2)
- For in him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily... (Col 2:9)
- And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth. (John 1:14)



2. Christ reveals Himself to the world through us, His Body



- ...you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house... a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. (1 Pet 2:5-9)
- ...just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another." (John 13:34-35)


3. Christ lives today through the gracefilled quality of our relationships, our deeds and our words (Rom 12:6-8)
