








6 **Be strong and courageous**. Do not fear or be in dread of them, for it is the LORD your God who goes with you. He will not leave you or forsake you.

7 Then Moses summoned Joshua and said to him in the sight of all Israel, "Be strong and courageous, for you shall go with this people into the land that the LORD has sworn to their fathers to give them, and you shall put them in possession of it.

23 And the Lord commissioned Joshua the son of Nun and said, "Be strong and courageous, for you shall bring the people of Israel into the land that I swore to give them. I will be with you."





Joshua needed Courage from obeying the word of God in the face of the challenges ahead.





No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life. Just as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you or forsake you. (v5)


Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go." (v9)



Joshua will not succeed because he obeys God's instruction; he will succeed because God is with him to enable him to obey his instruction.



God's presence enabled Joshua to obey His Word.



Every place that the sole of your (plural) foot will tread upon I have given to you (plural), just as I promised to Moses. From the wilderness and this Lebanon as far as the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites to the Great Sea toward the going down of the sun shall be your (plural) territory. (vv 3-4)

➤ the land is already given to the people of Israel, but they still had to exercise faith to go and physically occupy it


