

A. God allows us to experience setbacks, weakness and deprivation because He has a greater plan for us

Passover... No more manna... Circumcision

Jesus' betrayal, arrest, torture and death was not because God was powerless, but because God had a greater salvation plan



Matthew 26:52-54 Jesus said to him, "Put your sword back into its place. For all who take the sword will perish by the sword. 53 Do you think that I cannot appeal to my Father, and he will at once send me more than twelve legions of angels? 54 But how then should the Scriptures be fulfilled, that it must be so?"

Be not discouraged or shaken when we experience weakness or encounter setback, but continue trusting and growing stronger in Him while watching and waiting for His higher purpose to unfold.

B. God reminds us that He is sovereign over us as our Creator and Redeemer
