#### How should we understand warfare in Joshua 11?

The Conquest of Canaan took place between 1400-1200 BC

- 3,500 years ago
- 1,400 years before Christ
- 600 years before Rome was founded (753 BC)
- 1000 years before burial of Qin Shi Huang and his Terracotta Army (200 BC)


Warfare in those times was understood very differently

- → Cannot be used as justifications or models for modern conflicts
- → Cannot be used to justify 'scorched earth' total destruction today


# Understand the spiritual and social context for God's justice, promises and lessons for our faith

#### **The Conquest of Canaan**




Northern Campaign






#### PERSISTENCE IN FAITH


- 1. Like Joshua, we are called to persist in faith throughout our lives

### Joshua made war a long time with all those kings (Josh 11:18)




And the Lord said to Joshua, "Do not be afraid of them, for tomorrow at this time I will give over all of them, slain, to Israel" (Josh 11:6b)






Put on the whole armour of God... For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against... the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places



Our identity as God's people rests in faith in our Lord Jesus Christ



### Our identity as God's people rests in faith in our Lord Jesus Christ

I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. And the life that I now live in my body, I live by faith, indeed, by the faithfulness of God's Son, who loved me and gave himself for me Galatians 2:20 (NT Wright)

- Our lives are shaped and sustained by Christ living in us through the Spirit
- ❖ Our true identity is found in God's love shown through Jesus' sacrifice 'I think, therefore I am' (Descartes) → 'I am loved, therefore I am' (Paul)
- The love from the cross defines us and draws out an answering response of love from us, which is faith
- In this love we discover who we truly are in Christ and find real life in Him



Joshua fought many hard battles to conquer Canaan

Jesus fought the most important battle at the Cross
to conquer death and offer us eternal life

- Persisting in faith is our deeply joyful response to Jesus embracing us with His love shown at Calvary
- We are the Community of the Cross forgiven, adopted, united by faith, and called to live out this identity in love and holiness
